The Institute of Industrial Science (IIS) at the University of Tokyo is one of Japan's largest research institutes affiliated with a university. It comprises around 120 research laboratories, each directed by one faculty member. At IIS, approximately 1,350 individuals are engaged in education and research, including 380 faculty and staff members, 110 researchers, and 850 students. The research conducted here spans nearly all areas of engineering, from micro and nano scales, such as quantum levels, to larger scales that encompass global and space-related studies.

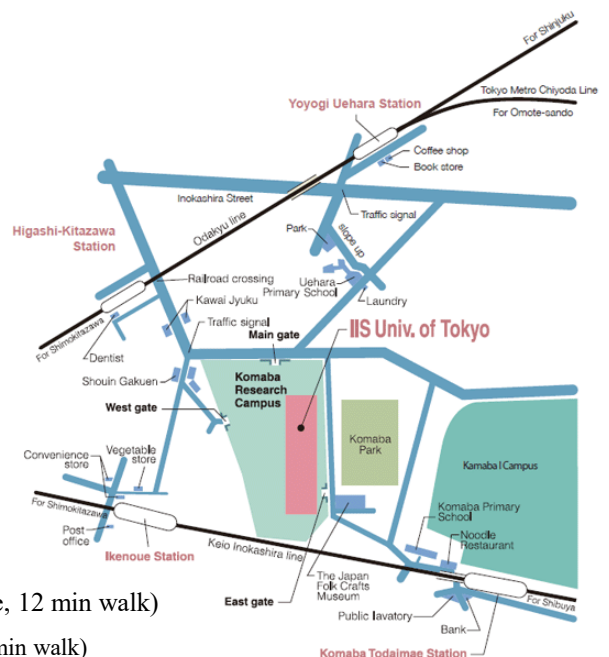
