

Notes on the Difference between Online and On-site Written Examinations

(1) Online connection testing might be held for those who are allowed to be transferred to the online written examinations; check the admission guide of each department. Those who fail to attend the connection testing (if it is held) will lose their eligibility for taking the entrance examinations. For the examinations of the general education subject (mathematics), no online connection testing is planned. Carefully read the “Examination guideline for the online examinations of the general education subject (mathematics)”, prepare the required facilities and have enough practice by yourself. Even if you encounter a trouble such as failing to submit your answer sheet in time due to the lack of enough preparation, there will be no relief measures.

(2) To prevent fraud and ensure fairness, we apply the following measures to the online written examinations.

1. During each test period, you cannot temporarily leave the room where you are taking the online examination, even when you wish to use the lavatory or do not feel well. Rules for leaving the room are defined for each examination subject. For the general education subjects, you must submit your answer sheets before you leave the room, and will not be allowed to come back to the room until the test period is finished. For the rules for leaving the room during each of the subjects in each department, consult the documents provided by the department.

2. There is a specific deadline for entering the room for the online examinations. After the deadline, you will not be allowed to enter the room.

3. All the online written examinations will be recorded. When necessary, during the oral examination in each department, you may be asked about your answers for the written examinations and how you came up with them. If it turns out that cheating occurred during your online written examination, the acceptance for your admission may be canceled even after the announcement of the examination result.
