Requirements of Eligibility for Special Admission for English Program on Intelligent Information Processing, Graduate School of Information Science and Technology, The University of Tokyo (Enrollment in October 2025)

The requirements for special admissions for English Program on Intelligent Information Processing, Graduate School of Information Science and Technology, the University of Tokyo (Enrollment in October 2025) are as follows. Applicants must satisfy all the requirements stated below.

- 1. Each applicant must have a desire to enroll at the University of Tokyo as an international student, if selected. In principle, applicants must come to Japan as new international students. Those who are applying for other MEXT scholarship programs (e.g., Embassy Recommendation, or University Recommendation from other universities; except those who have already failed Primary Selection), those who are receiving or confirmed to receive MEXT scholarship, and in principle, those who have received MEXT scholarship in the past are not eligible.
- 2. Applicant must have a nationality of a country with diplomatic relations with the Japanese government.
- * Applicants who have Japanese nationality at the time of application are ineligible.
- 3. In principle, applicants must be born on or after April 2nd, 1990.

4. Academic Background

Applicants must have the necessary qualifications to be admitted to the master's program or doctoral program of the Graduate School of Information Science and Technology, the University of Tokyo. Refer to the admission guides for regular admission, available at the following URL.

Note that the descriptions of those admission guides, except "Requirements for Eligibility," are not applicable to this special admission.

Since the admission date is different, please replace "March 31, 2025" with "September 30, 2025" in the Requirements for Eligibility.

5. Field of Study

Applicants should have studied information science and technology or related fields at their previous universities (at a Graduate or Undergraduate level).

6. Language Proficiency

Applicants must satisfy at least one of the following requirements:

- (i) At the time of entering our graduate school, applicants have certificates from standard language tests which prove that applicants' language capability is no less than CEFR B2 (See * below).
- (ii) Applicants have completed the education required for entrance into the master's program or doctoral program of the Graduate School of Information Science and Technology, the University of Tokyo (see Section 4 above), using English as the primary language.
- (iii) The University of Tokyo certifies that applicants have English capabilities equivalent to or better than that required in item (i).

In the case of (i) or (ii), the applicants must provide documents that prove those conditions.

The applicant in (i) must obtain and submit a score within its period of validity (tests must have been taken after February 2023) by the application deadline.

In the case of (iii), a pre-interview will be conducted for evaluation of English capability, so please declare your desired time frames to take the pre-interview through the WEB application system when you create your page.

7. Arrival Time in Japan

In principle, applicants should arrive in Japan during the period specified by the University of Tokyo, which will be in September or October 2025.

8. Visa Requirement

In principle, applicants should first obtain a new "Student" visa at a Japanese embassy or consulate in their country of nationality, and then enter Japan with a new status of residence of "Student."

9. Non-eligibility

Persons who fall under any of the following categories are ineligible for this special admission.

- (1) Those who are military personnel or military civilian employees at the time of their arrival in Japan or during the period of enrollment.
- (2) Those who plan to engage in long-term research (such as internship or fieldwork) outside Japan or plan to take a long-term leave of absence from the university after enrolling.
- (3) Those who have no intention of obtaining a degree.

10. Notes

Upon their enrollment at the University of Tokyo, successful applicants must register for "English Program on Intelligent Information Processing."
